Born in Naples, but raised in L'Aquila, Simona Molinari approached the world of music from a very young age, starting to study singing at the age of eight, to then focus first on pop music and jazz, and then on classical music, until reaching the diploma at the conservatory Alfredo Casella dell'Aquila..

After a few years spent singing in Italian piano bars, in 2006 he took part in the April 25 Prize, obtaining recognition as Best singer.

In 2007 he began collaborating with the producer Carlo Avarello, carrying out a project aimed at jazz-pop. In the same year he also made his debut in the theater field, collaborating on some projects signed by the composer and author Davide Cavuti starring the Italian actors Michele Placido, Edoardo Siravo and Caterina Vertova. Furthermore, in 2007 he performed the Italian version of the musical Jekyll & Hyde, whose cast also includes Giò Di Tonno. In an interview of 31 January 2013 with Citofonare Cuccarini, Molinari says that an artist who has always been inspired since she was a child is Giorgia.
